Instead, we are successful, hard working, tax paying, professionals from diverse fields of work, which include law, architecture, corporate planning, journalism, high-tech graphics, real estate brokerage, entertainment industry, nurses, social workers and many others.
- **WE ARE NOT** funded by any outside organization. All money has been painstakingly raised and donated by our group, in order to bring another perspective to the table.
- **WE ARE NOT** NIMBYs. We do believe, however, that the city as a whole will be poorly served, if at all, by this helipad. Please read our carefully researched materials as to why this is an unneeded and unsafe helipad placed in the midst of a densely populated residential area. on this neighborhood without an honest discussion.

Only after both sides of this issue have been carefully discussed can a thoughtful decision on a helipad be made. Our primary goal is to make sure that an alternate perspective is heard.
